Saxophones (C4-F6)

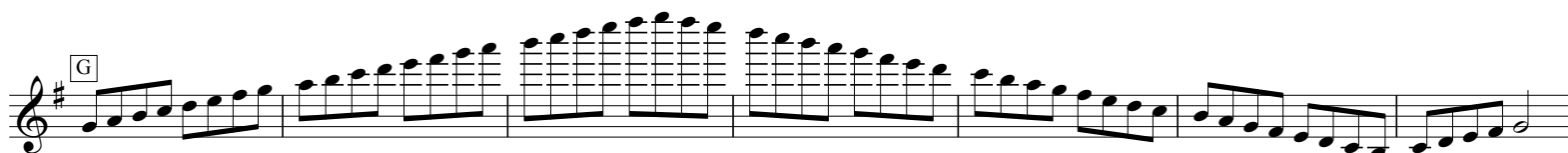
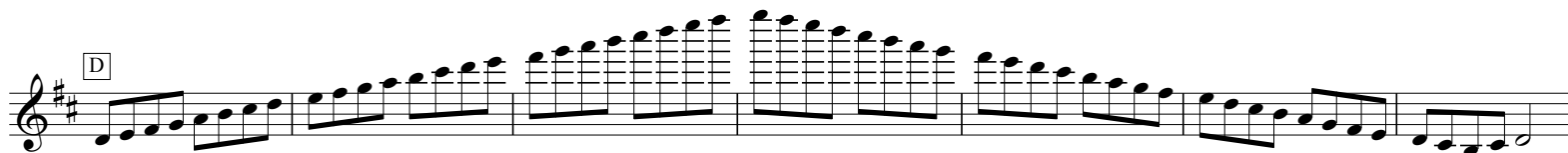
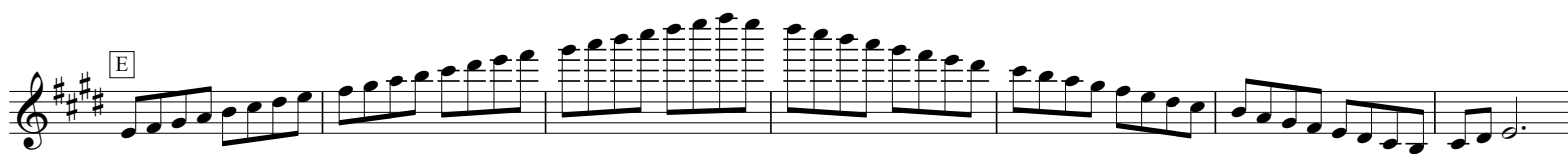
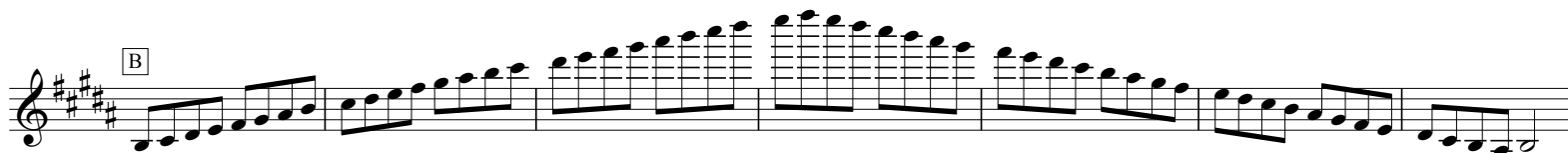

- Ab Major:** Ascending: Ab4-Bb4-Ab4-G4-F4-E4-D4 (quarter notes). Descending: Ab4-Bb4-Ab4-G4-F4-E4-D4 (quarter notes).
- C# Major:** Ascending: C#4-D#4-E#4-F#4-G#4-A#4-B#4 (quarter notes). Descending: C#4-D#4-E#4-F#4-G#4-A#4-B#4 (quarter notes).
- F# Major:** Ascending: F#4-G#4-A#4-B#4-C#5-B#4-A#4-G#4-F#4 (quarter notes). Descending: F#4-G#4-A#4-B#4-C#5-B#4-A#4-G#4-F#4 (quarter notes).
