

Major Scales

Piccolo (G4-A6)

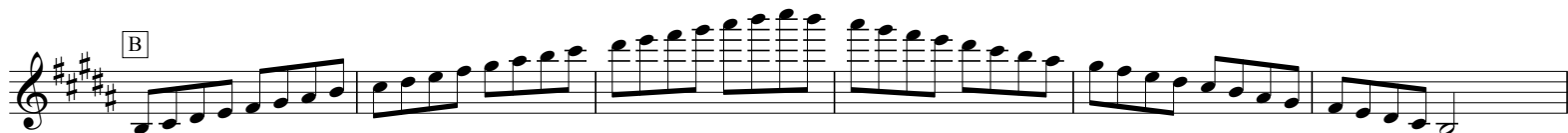

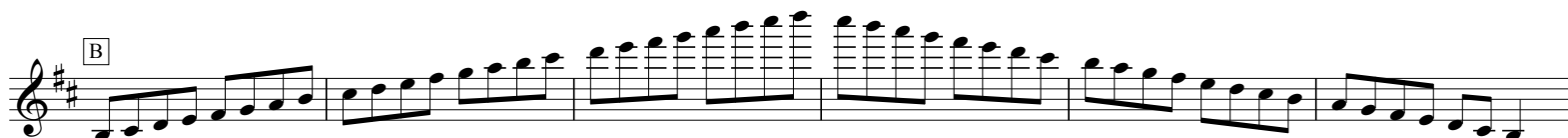

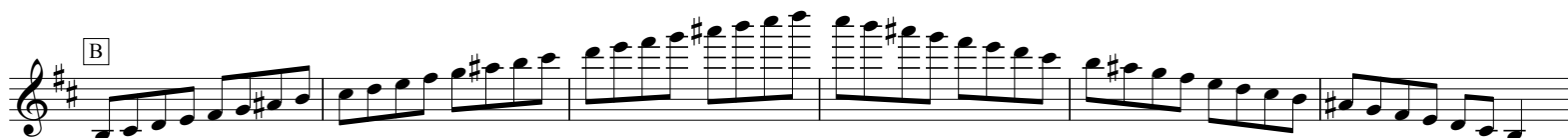

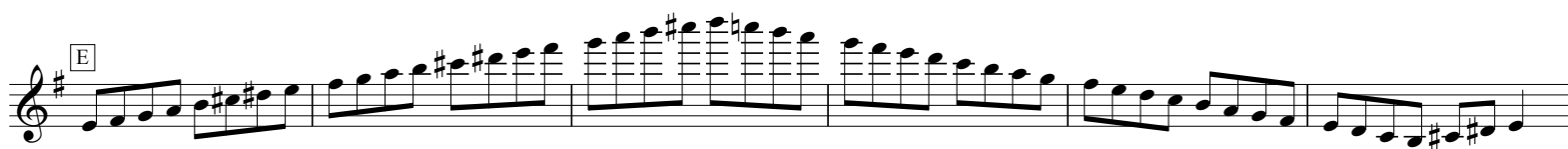

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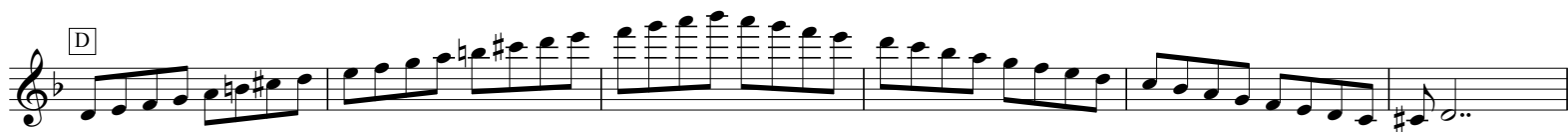
